



## **HLSI COVID-19 UPDATE 1.9.21**

We look forward to welcoming you to HLSI this term. Please take note of these measures, brought in for the safety and confidence of everyone using HLSI. We continue to ask that masks are worn in the building. Please also maintain distance from others out of respect for their health. Hand sanitiser is available in the foyer and you are asked to use this before entering. In addition, we encourage all users of the building to be vaccinated and to take lateral flow tests before visiting us. This is in acknowledgment that even if vaccinated, people may become asymptotically infected and pass the disease to others. Staff working in the building are now obliged to follow these measures.

## **LIBRARY AND ARCHIVE**

Library visits no longer need to be booked in advance, but access to the library is limited so you may find you are asked to wait for a short time in the Members Room or outside the building. The library opening hours are published online and in the monthly Update messages. Those wishing to study Archive material should make an arrangement in advance and it will be brought out to a vacant classroom at the appointed time.

We plan to re-open the Members Room for seated reading and socialising from 28 September. Numbers will be limited and managed by a member of staff working at a desk in the room. Masks should be worn, please.

It is likely that we will continue to require online booking for most events in the Autumn and you will find further information on the website. Highgate Gallery exhibitions will continue with numbers in the hall limited and visitors asked to wear masks.
